<b>DRYLAND PASTURE MIX (seeding rate 25#/ac)</b>		
Available in 50# sacks and 10# sacks		
<i>Good forage, great competition for weeds, good for erosion control, good reclamation mix, good for dry to semi irrigated land.</i>		
<i>Compared to the Dryland Reclamation Mix below, this has more leaf and higher production for grazing situations.</i>

It has been adapted for reclamation/restoration in the medium to cooler mountain climates, and is recommended for low-growing cover. It is also used as a low-maintenance turf in the Rocky Mountain area.</i>

This mix grows well along the front range, western slope, and Wyoming front range, thrives in areas with morning sun, but will tolerate shade. This mix can tolerate dryland situations but requires supplemental water at lower elevations. For best results, plant half in late fall and half in early spring and/or consider planting with our Western Wildflower Mix.

Planting Rate/Acre: 6-12 lbs
